## To Captain John Smith & the Settlers Bound for Virginia:

We trust that you will want to avoid the fate of the colonists at Roancke. We expect that you will follow our instructions precisely when choosing your site and in other matters that are important to this enterprise.

## Griteria for Site:

- 4. Must be a healthful and fertile place.

Include a sketch of your settlement including its basic shape, location of defensive structures, and division of space within the settlement.

## **Settlement by the Virginia Company**

- b) What problems exist with your chosen location?
- c) What effects are these problems likely to have on the colonists?
